Selected recipients are awarded a \$1,000 cash honorarium, an engraved award plaque, and complimentary registration for the physician and spouse/guest to attend all professional and social functions of the NPOS Annual Meeting.

There will be a minimum of two awards presented at the meeting, with additional awards possible depending upon the selection committee's assessment of the quality of abstracts received.
